- 14 Made a large washing. began to rain Far came
- 15 Home Jimmie went to Lancaster and took 2 cows
- 16 Still showery put the colts to Carrony farm
- 17 Looked like being dry I went to Murchison and got 45 strawberry plants and planted them and while I was on the road, the rain poured down Tom Collet put 1 cow in pasture
- 18 Sowed carrots, but mangolds, turneps
- 19 dry today cold wind, Jimmie ploughed the lot at the farm, we will plant it tomorrow <sup>colt</sup> ~~took~~ <sup>out</sup>
- 20 Began to rain about 9.30 last night and it has been showery & drizzle ever since 11 P.M. Marion sold 2 doz eggs at W. got a pair of hore <sup>22</sup> and a yd <sup>22</sup> of pink ribbon for herself, she got a pair of boots <sup>1:20</sup> 1.27 I was working at an old dress of Marions, to put up a fence for Collet today, paid W. Gordon 75 cts for nailing the boards, paid Collet 50 cts for digging 10 post holes, we did not plant potatoes today
- 21 The day cool. Mr O'Brien preached read Exodus 15<sup>th</sup> P.M. read Rev 14<sup>th</sup> part of 15<sup>th</sup>
- 22 Saw mosquitoes today for the first <sup>the year</sup> ~~of~~ <sup>of</sup> 15<sup>th</sup>
- 23 Jimmie is ploughing, the boy fixed the fences planted the lot by the barn corn & potatoes & pumpkins
- 24 Fine day Jimmie sowed 10 bush provender, I planted beans W. Melan M. melon's cucumber & Broad onions & sweet corn the boys but Randolph went to Lancaster to see

- 25 A game of Lacrosse, between Lancaster & Cornwall Jimmie & Mandy, Far put a platform at the cook house door Dan Ferguson, one all, put this cow into our pasture so did lastridge.
- 26 Mosquitoes in myriads, the home is full of them, sold 2 doz eggs 25 cts got sulphur 5 cts. Cleaned up the door yard 5  
Dan is fishing and selling success, letter from Mandy
- 27 Rained a little this morning enough to settle the dust Rev Mr Peterson of Marshfield who is at Falls, preached read Isaiah 60. & 5 of Matth text from the 3 to the 17 some of the 5 chap of Matth. that was Morning evening read Proverbs 8 chap. & 2d Corinth 4 chap first 14 verse of 5 chap 2d Cor. I liked his reading if his voice were good. He is a tall and has a beard head looks like Principal Grant
- 28 Dull day with frequent showers Jimmie sowed provender. Bird has tooth ache. There was an explosion in Gas works in Montreal on Saturday. 4 men killed & 5 seriously injured. ~~Two~~ <sup>one</sup> ~~of~~ <sup>the</sup> ~~children~~ <sup>was</sup> ~~in~~ <sup>in</sup> St Mary's today ~~with~~ <sup>the</sup> ~~children~~ <sup>daughter</sup> and a ~~daughter~~ <sup>daughter</sup> of Bertha. and Salary
- 29 Able had a mare well about 10 P.M. it was at the as jet.
- 30 We were cutting potatoes for planting, Jimmie went this afternoon to plough at the 30 acres he sent 4 bush of oats to Murchison who is going to plant them on shares of Sullivan put cow in pasture so did Tom Collet
- 31 I was busy all day and did not go to Prayer Meeting was cutting potatoes. They planted about 10 bush on village farm.
- 32 Far went this morning to Montreal to hear Gillmore's band of instrumental music. Mandy & Dan finished planting potatoes, we have in all over 30 bush potatoes plant
