 at times got exceedingly stormy and snowing
 at night. Willie drove down in morning
 brought up Maay I cleaned seed oats
 Mr Cook in in morning got load of ~~stake~~
 pig crate. Mr Brown and two youngest girls in
 after dinner I gave him a cheque on R.B. for
 \$13.00 missionary money for Reading Camp Mission
 X I drove up to Armstrongs at night through
 the drifts and storm. Willie and the girls went
 to Lindels at night then Willie walked down home
 stayed with mother all night.

25 52 Mostly cloudy got colder by night stormy P.M.
 Willie came up this morning We loaded 5 pigs
 on rack Mr Fancit helped us and Willie took
 them down cold to Cameron 990 lbs at
 \$4.10 per cwt \$138.60 weighing 10 cts Mr Cook
 brought back pig crate. Mr Lees in returned 1.00
 we sent him to pay Brooks. P.M I drove ^{and Bella} Maay down
 in sleigh took cat and took down to M. Kenzie for
 Fancit. took girls in to call on Mrs Pick, brought up 20 or less shots
 1000 lbs from Simmons Maay came up with one Bella stayed down. Willie
 got at 7 & Sherrill sugar \$25.17 barley 25
