Thursday 23rd fine

C Plowed headland around root field & we started to hoe mangels in field

Friday 24th fine

We hoed mangels and father cultivated & rolled rape ground.

Saturday 25th fine

L. & H. Morris hoed mangels & picked mustard. We went through all the spring grain, and we went to town for groceries \$2⁰⁰ and oat meal \$1²⁰ ^{next yr} ~~land~~

for Cabbage. Charlie's ^{17th} Churn. Mr Dancer came this evening.

Sunday 26th fine

Father & Mary & Jennie went to Church in morning and mother, Mary & I in evening
