- April 14<sup>th</sup> Drew manure to the garden & cleaned out the closet.
- " 16 - A very wet day, turning nice near evening.
- " 17 - Went to Paris for Edith & Leone where they had stayed at Strand.
- " 18 - Good Friday and a very nice day. Tree for a few days
- " 19 - Don & Jack Gullen come up for the holidays & F. Archibald from the
- " 22 - Harrowed creek field and started to cultivate in back field for corn.
- " 23 - A very cold wind yesterday and to-day, turning to snow to-night.
- " - - - - - Blw up a big stone in creek field with stamping powder.
- " 24 - Don & Jack Gullen went home in the evening.
- " 28 - Duncan & Aunt Susie Forster came for a visit.
- " 29 - Dan came at noon, to start to work.
- " 30 - Sowed 75 lbs. oats in back ten acre field.  
The goose hatched out 12 little goslings.  
Went to Bob Deale in the evening for a little calf.
- May 1<sup>st</sup>. A wet day, drew a load of ~~salt~~ from Ronald bush.
- " 2<sup>nd</sup>. Finished sowing mixed grain in 3 acre field.
- " 3<sup>rd</sup> 4 Some very heavy rains which kept the seeding back.
- " 5<sup>th</sup>. Went to Jim Jenkins for a load of straw in forenoon  
and rolled hay field & started to plow garden & plant early.
- " 7 - <sup>Went to meeting of Programme committee @ St. Agnes.</sup>  
Sold 7 bags of ~~pl~~ Plenumorris 1370 lbs @ 30<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> per lbs.
- " 8 - Finished sowing mixed grain in creek field.
- " 9 - Sowed late barley & Sugar - Came on a ~~ccc~~ back a driving sled.
- " 10 - A very wet day. Cleaned and oiled the heavy harness.  
Sent out report forms to the different P.B.s.
- " 14 - Finished cultivating & rolling the corn & manure ground.
