PM Albert Boys and son Robert also Stanley Contridge up Stanley helped Willie finish pulling mustard in No 5 then they helped the rest of us hoe corn. we got about 16 rows done. Rev Aitchison came in to see if we could get bread power away so I went up after tea brought down a load of pieces. Mrs Jamieson and Edith Allan called in evening. lightning and heat at night

Thursday

Fine day sunny and cloudy very warm a few drops rain AM. A Boys & son Robert & Stanley up all day. We got 30 rows corn hoed Willie went up to Aitchison in morning got rest of bread power then scuffled turnips. X Willie and Stanley took 'Midge' up to Meadows after dinner. Willie drove Mary and mother down home in evening

Fine sunny day not quite so warm. Albert Boys & son Stanley, and Neville Hill up all day. We got the 18 drill turnips next manys thinned also 16 more drills corn. Willie down town PM Kate in buggy took her up to Browns saw M: D read and his horse there. Mary came up PM she paid the following bills Stub Bros 16 24 dress goods \$7.82 for Woods bill \$16.24 25 also rubber rings 10.5 got at Phillips camp for power 25.5 at Jamiesons bananas 18 ct
