took the Basket Mr Douglas and
Banking and Plastering the Horse
Stable the colt got loose eat a
Little too much oats very Windy
Mr Barnhart stopt here to night from Sunday
took Ducks to Jo's 16th Fine Seander and
Barnhart went to the Kettle Mr Seaman
and Frank here Bought 5 Bushels of Potatoes
2 Dollars 4 lb of Butter 72 cents gave him
a Kettle of Butter-milk now going off
Fernandez took a sack of Fine Salt
Randolph here Seander got 11 Ducks 17th
Fine Day Mr Hume here Bought 1 Gallon
of Syrup 80 1 Bushel of Pease 60 Took
Home the Plate and Kettle Mr D. Mervin
and Randolph here took me over to the
Pedar-Grove to have a Scotch soil
Then Ducks Banking the House
Fine went to the Bay for Wood Corn
near for oil Sent him the Big
Came Fernandez and him Fish
plastering Stables
