Wednesday

Cloudy day heavy rain all last night come in P.M. We brought over load hay and fixed doors in other barn in A.M.

In P M I hauled back and spread 5 loads
manure. Willie went up to Allans for
spreader in evening. Peter Spunk here for tea.

Thursday

Cloudy day raining heavy in P M again
very wet weather. We took 10 bags chop
down to Lulliss and brought up spruce
from Mrs Gibbons Willie went down
again for chop⁵⁰ got harness mended²⁰ veats
flat oil³⁰ soap⁵ eye¹⁰ meat at Mills²⁵
Wrother up in P M. A horse buyer in in
P M looking at hross. I went up to Tom
Broadfords in P M see about Dick's leg.
We took 3 calves down home to pasture tonight.
