 Cold high wind had O. Montroy 2 hours putting out manure. It was so cold they could not work
 23 Fine bright day. Jimie had Montroy on
 24 day. Jimie found in the manure at the horse stable stove. John Robertson's pocket-book it was all rotten. 70 rood wheat
 44 Murdy came last night
 25 Bright day like soap day. Birdie and the children came to stay a few days
 26 To pan board 20 Jimie got ten and half from C. Brown
 27 Bright but cold. The babies not too well Charlotte Mc Gillis ^{deceased} wife with us. Poured rain all day. Dan McDonald, who died in Toronto, in Jan. was buried here today. Mrs Kennedy and Blara were in for a while in the evening.
- 28 May. called in afternoon. Tassie at night
 The babies are not very well. Rain in afternoon. D. Saddlers ^{wife} was in all afternoon
 29 To 2 pans bread 40. 2 lbs bacon 35. molasses 15. 2 blerd 1. 20
 30 1 gall coal oil 20. Bellinus stable shed then house
 were burned in afternoon. The people had to work hard to save the house. Dingwall's little house on the other street caught fire but the roof was well watered & escaped

April 1906

1. Very fine bright day. Birdie went to church. She went home in the afternoon. The children were better.
 2 Agnes is two years old today. Murdy went to Cornwall to attend the King's Bench. I made a small washup Murdy came in evening, and went back, he said he forgot some papers
 3 Rain today. Jimie tapped a few trees at home
 4 I sat the beach.
 5 Fine day. no frost last night Murdy not back
 6 Fine day. Lizzie Brown called her baby is three weeks old, made about a cup full of syrup
 7 Murdy got home about 7.30. 70 gloves 25. Ball 10
 8 I boiled a pot of soap
 9 Fine day.
 10 I was in church, we had a good sermon
 11 Dull day, had Ann Hall yr day, passing ²⁵
 12 Ugly day now and rush. We are 44 years in the spoke
 13 Kind of dull. Moun Kewins is in tragic capture, on the 10th the people in all the neighbouring villages had to clear for their lives ^{Yesterdays}
 14 Drizzle of rain Kimp was here and tuned the piano
 15 Pa got a recym from Mrs Dowd - for \$11.00. interest on a mortgage. Jimie was away all day looking for pike, got a fine big fellow
 16 Yesterday, Kewins took another direction for her lava and two towns, one N. E. the other N. West were pretty well demolished
 17 Magachy brought 30 lbs maple sugar 10 frons 20 for Uncle Sandy. And 5 gall of syrup for us. It began to rain about 5
 18 Had a letter from Marion, sold the eggs 4 doz 6. 76^{cts}. 1 lb tea 25 gave two doz to a widow Bellinus put up a little stable between the house and the village this week
