- Fri Sept 12th rain all day commenced light in morning kept coming faster until it rained heavy in the afternoon. Thomas Farrell's wife was buried this afternoon.
- Sat Sept 13th clear and cool.
- Sun Sept 14th clear and cool. a sharp frost last night
- Mon Sept 15th hazy and warm. I took Millie a few pears this fore noon after noon gather'd my onions
- Tue Sept 16th clear and hot. I went down to the old home this fore noon for a apple rack to dry apples. Dick and Maude is away to London fair. after noon I shell'd corn for the chickens
- Wed Sept 17th clear and warm. I was digging potatoes. Sarah was here pickling pears

- Thu Sept 18th cloudy and warm. I dug potatoes in the fore noon. after was peeling apples
- Fri Sept 19th cloudy and warm rain last night. I finished digging potatoes
- Sat Sept 20th cloudy fore noon rain last night clear this afternoon. Sarah was here part of the day baking and doing house work.
- Sun Sept 21st clear part of the day and warm
- Mon Sept 22nd clear and hot in the middle of the day. I pitid my potatoes. Mary Paul was here a few ~~mean~~ minutes after noon
- Tue Sept 23rd clear and hot fore noon. after noon cloudy wet this evening. Sarah was helping make crout
- Wed Sept 24th cloudy rain all night and this fore noon. I made candles and peel'd apples
- Thu Sept 25th cloudy and wet rain all night and commenced again this afternoon the ground soaked with water I peel'd and dryed apples.
