went to Wal & Birge Bellie & Wm. Stevens come from Delta

Snow this morning for 3 hours very stormy wind & snow

26 the roads is completely blocked up no going

27 Wal & Bellie started ^{on the road} for Delta this afternoon

28 Malcom come to work this morning that is the

first since tuesday night he got on the sled

he cut wood in the shed we killed a pig

29 Rev. Mr. Forrest preached this morning Mr. Patterson at

30 Wallace Wm. Ellen-Tennet. Birge and Long gone
went to Mr. Starks in Pittsburgh I did the chores

31 Malcom and Wallace went out to the 6th town

Wallace brought a load of wood home

Malcom staid a hour to chop fire day
