rack. Mary went down home 9 AM she and  
mother went to see remains of Mrs Abbie Wilson.  
her funeral to-day. she got ment at <sup>#103</sup> ~~the~~ <sup>103</sup>  
got ride up with I and Small who is painting house  
at Rev Aitchmans. Diamond boy in at noon today  
for a job. A man from Kenilworth on a motor  
cycle who had been at Wats annual Mother's  
sale came in for to fix his motor with coolant.
