Fine Mr Hamilton here Gordon Thornton Gray  
D Spunk John took me down a letter from  
Brockville from C Mallory on Hunting  
a a Package for Luvina a Yacht came  
up last night stopt at Alexas Island  
a mistake this above is the 9<sup>th</sup> 8<sup>th</sup> Put  
in the Tobacco 1 ~~th~~ Put  
Drew some Drags Took the saw logs  
up on the Bank Fine Windy hung up  
5 stalks of different kind Deline Bosell  
was to be married to Day  
11<sup>th</sup> Wind cool very fine Mowing in the front  
Marsh made 25 coils Stanley and Leander  
and Charlie Creamer went to Dundee took  
2 of the Lambs at 3 Dollars a piece sent  
of 2 Letters one to Brockville put up an  
other quilt on the Frames 2 Men on the  
Sturgeon Island Hunters I think from the Yacht  
Lily 12<sup>th</sup> Frost & Wind Fine Cool Trimming  
some of the apple trees took up some apples  
fixing Rafts on the West Shed Foggy  
seen Wild Geese Stanley and Jona Milled a  
Weasel Fleovy nuts Falling Leander came  
had the other 100 of Flour

Mr Miles Cameron Island 13<sup>th</sup> Oct 1892  
Fine Day Stanley and I to Hamiltons Got 8 Bushels  
of Apples Mr Kenneth Ross from Lancaster for  
apples John's Niece and family there John Ross  
there for the Buggy Tom Ploughing the Yacht  
Lily stopt at the Wharf sent a letter to  
a R. P. Powter got a Bill from Dr Peeling apples  
the Star come for the first time  
to Day for 5 Months 25 cents 1/4<sup>th</sup> Fine Putting  
out manure on the Potato ground Peeling  
apples Narcisse for Butter matched Tobacco  
15<sup>th</sup> Fine Day Mr Gene came cutting Pine  
made a small stack of 40 coils in the  
front marsh Hung up all the Tobacco in the  
Store-house heard Bull Frogs to night Leander  
went to the south side got 2 Waterhens Leander  
and Mr Gene went fishing to night Went to  
the Sturgeon Island trimmed some Trees Burnt some  
weeds 16<sup>th</sup> Fine Mr Gene went off the girls  
and Stanley went to Hamiltons for the Mail  
3 Hunters came to the shanty Saturday night  
Last night the 2 Hunters here for Milk I treated  
with a good Co of Rum Bought Milk  
17<sup>th</sup> Fine Putting out Manure Hunters  
for Milk Ducks not plenty found  
another of the sheep Dead at the Head  
of the Island Forced John's Burn some  
the Alexandra went down to Day and  
Tuesday is her Day to go down 18<sup>th</sup> Fine Foggy  
this Morning Putting out Manure Lots of Shooting  
to Day Rained Heavy to night  
St Lukes Day Leander shot a Duck sold  
it to the Hunters
