Cyanosis in Nitrous Oxide-Oxygen Narcosis.

Under the influence of this anesthetic there is increased blood pressure. The gravity of this condition depends very largely, however, upon the amount of cyanosis which is permitted and upon the degree to which rebreathing is allowed. When properly administered there is practically no cyanosis and the venous hemorrhage is of little or no consequence.—
