oil cake. \$1.25 also pd \$3.75 1.25  
for. 500<sup>00</sup> bran. to be sent out 3.75

Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> fine  
Geo at Barbers thrashing yesterday  
afternoon and this forenoon  
Father plowed and I picked  
apples.
