Father and mother came up for dinner and tea Maggie Mitchell up for tea Willie drove them down in evening I started to plow No 5 P.M. when I saw a crowd at line fence between us and Fords and learned that Geo Felkin had shot himself while climbing the fence. we did not plow any more. They carried his body up to our other barn and Thompsons rig came and took it away. We did some more to henhouse.</p>					50
