Bella and I drove down to Methodist church where Mr. Clegg preached from except the Lord build the house thy labor in vain who build it and Except the Lord keep the city etc. we gave 50cts well. Willi plowed No 5 A.M. Father and mother came up for dinner and tea Maggie Mitchell up for tea Willi drove them down in evening I started to plow No 5 PM when I saw a crowd at line fence between us and roads and learned that Geo Felkin had shot himself while climbing the fence we did not plow any more. they carried his body up to our other barn and Thompson's rig came and took it away. We did some more to barnhouse.		50
