Tuesday

Mostly cloudy very warm sunny at times  
 Raining at times both AM and PM the latter  
 there was thunder lightning dark clouds.

We sorted potatoes in cellar cut some for  
 seed plowed & harrowed potato land spread  
 3 loads manure spreader etc and got  
 3 more rows potatoes planted as stated in 25th  
 Willie drove down home at night for papers etc.

27

Wednesday

Very warm sunny day. Willie took 10.32  
 lbs potatoes to Armstrongs @ 75 ds bag \$8.60 m  
 ofr got com 65 ds lemons 10 or ofr rivets  
 for manure spreader Manure 1 ds. I worked  
 at mending spreader AM. PM we made  
 some more potato drills 23 in all, planted  
 some more as follows New Antoinis (supplied)  
 all 13 and 1/2 14 from top finish 14 with common.  
 15 Pride of Britain (supplied) large potatoes cut then 16 from top  
 down 3/4 small potatoes (Pd B) and cut off 17 common  
 bottom Goldwin top 18 all Goldwin. Bunting got  
 1/2 dy eggs 13 Mrs. Mitch 1 doz 15 bought from  
 pedlar boy dry goods 55 ds. 7 other cups  
 PM with 12 Herbert raspberries (Rivier's Marans)  
 we planted them in garden evening. Old sheep has  
 two week lambs they are feeding cows milk from bottle.  
 the mangels have been up for some days growing with.
