- 26th Finished drawing in Lucerne 2 1/2 loads off centre east field making 3 1/2 loads of very fine hay.
Aunt Edith made a Birthday Supper out on the lawn to celebrate Dora's birthday.
- 28 Finished harvest, 13 loads of oats off 10 a crec in back 14 acre field and 1/2 load of raskings.
- 29 Will Millers came over for dinner and brought Miss Jackson over to help Edith for a while. Gordon Anderson came up for a little while, also Clarence Lee & family.
- 30 Leon's third Birthday, Mayme with Ivan & Ruth & Don were here for supper but went home after supper.
- 31 Dr Dutton came out with his car and we took Edith down to the Hospital at Brantford where our little son John Andrew was born.
- Sept 2nd Started to plow in creek field for wheat.
- 4th Spent Sunday in Brantford, most of the day at the Hospital with Edith and the Baby. Went to Gullens for dinner.
- 9 Went to Maggie Griens funeral in the afternoon. A nice rain in the afternoon after a very dry spell.
