1930

- 23<sup>rd</sup> Drew in 2 loads of Lucerne off north hill and went to G.F.O. Picnic at Fred Lucks flats in afternoon. Bevier Drury, H.C. Nixon and others spoke. The day was fine and there was a large crowd there. Mayme & Ivan Kuff came for a few hours.
- 24<sup>th</sup> Finished drawing in Lucerne & 5 loads off centre east field making 35 loads of very fine hay.
- Aunt Edith made a Birthday Supper out on the lawn to celebrate Don's birthday.
- 28<sup>th</sup> Finished harvest. 13 loads of oats off 10 acres in back 14 acre field and 2 load of raking.
- 29<sup>th</sup> Bill Miller came over for dinner and brought his Jackson over to help Edith for a while. Gordon Gravenee came up for a little while, also Clarence Lee & family.
- 30<sup>th</sup> Leone's third Birthday. Mayme with Ivan & Ruth & Don were here for supper but went home after supper.
- 31<sup>st</sup> Dr Dutton came out with his car and we took Edith down to the Hospital at Brantford where our little Son John Andrew was born.
- Sept 2<sup>nd</sup> Started to plow in creek field for wheat.
- 4<sup>th</sup> Spent Sunday in Brantford, most of the day at the Hospital with Edith and the Baby. Went to Yaller for dinner.
- 9<sup>th</sup> Went to Maggie Greive's funeral in the afternoon. A nice rain in the afternoon after a very dry spell.
