going home to day as fish dont
well keeping the cows from coming
in apples falling 10th a very
fine day very foggy this morning
a great many boats went
to day setting fires in the
upper field fishing perch
Randolph got his Mast and Kudda
Seander went to J Corvington
binding some sheafs of Corn
Stalks Lewis for butter
The exhibition in Montreal
11th Trimming an Oak and Maple
on the Pitt Point Gentry to Butter
and Potatoes 30 got 2 Sturgeon
12th Fine & Wind a Race the Rockett
and Bohemian the Bohemian
caught her and passed the
Gentry went off took up some
6 Bushels of apples Mr Gene
went to Cornwall had 2 Boats

James Cameron Island 13th Sept 1896
& Wind Fernandez John to Gordon
Came Gordon graded this watch
for a Boat she got with
John Hamilton Gordon Seander
Randolph making Ready to go
to the Exhibition in Montreal
tomorrow at 5 o'clock they
went up to the Point 14th
Fine the 3 Boys went to Montreal
Mr Gene came from Cornwall
cutting corn stalks taking in
apples cutting in the garden
15th Fine & Wind Mr Gene went to
Dundee to sell apples gave
him money to Buy Sugar
Ball of Thread a corn propper
cutting rushes at the entrance
of the Ditch Taking in apples
cutting corn stalks went to
The upper Point Mr Gene
came sugar Thread corn propper Randolph
came 16th Seander came St Paul
Andrews & propper all night Lewis for
Butter Barry for Randolph setting
fires allen Cameron had 3 Boats
