I made fence to divide No 6 from Sndor 11 to  
 slings fence then disked manuel land till even  
 Willie plowed (4 horses) then harrowed manuel land  
 till about 11 then went down took 630 lbs bone  
 pig chaff to Carters 25cts per bushel wilens (8 miles) \$6.24  
 96 cts worth eggs dressing salt & groats 50 ave  
 min 4cts got 11.00 from mother for what to begin him  
 In PM we got manuel land worked got 12  
 drills made and sown with Rennies

which was soaked 24 hours then dried to  
 sow. We sown 140 lbs salt more or less on land  
 before drilling. We braced turnips over shafts.

Sunday

Fine day, got cold at night. James Paulin  
 preached in our church in AM from Matt  
 4:10 and in evening from 2 Kings 7:3. Uncle  
 Will drove him down in morning and up at night.  
 Frank Dodge over for dinner. Girls drove him right  
 down coll 6.00 Special 10 cts & met Paulin in  
 Toronto hospital has undergone operation for appendicitis -

not last night very cold windy day sunny  
 and cloudy. We fixed fence dividing No 6 and  
 brought over load hay worked green cropland by  
 Mr Bass over in evening & Willie took the rest of  
 his waffed hay over with Jack, light wagon  
 got on it \$1.00. Tom McIke over in evening to see  
 about getting manure spreader. I sown two  
 more bags salt on manuel land to day.
