Biliary vs. Renal Colic.

At times it is difficult to distinguish between biliary and renal colic. The points of importance, not always conclusive, however, are that in renal colic the pain rarely extends above the waist line, but radiates into the groin and into the thigh, and that a specimen of urine examined immediately after the attack shows red blood cells. An X-ray examination usually reveals the stone in the kidney or ureter, and does not as a rule bring out gallstones.—D. Riesman; Pa. Med. Journ.
