Bella over at Mackies P.M. both Mrs Mackie and Mrs Faucet are sick. Willie drove home also downtown Lamy in cutter P.M.

Saturday

Cloudy a little stormy and snowing considerable especially A.M. frosty. Willie worked at sorting turnips as they are rotting I finished cleaning wheat. P.M. I took 2 loads manure from pig pen to pile in No 2 Willie drove down P.M. took to Russells 11 eggs 35cts got tea and sugar 90cts. I walked down town at night. Mr. Billie in A.M. to see if we had pigs to sell.
