 7<sup>th</sup> Heller's Birth Day Fine Windy  
 Mr Gene went off have the Loan of one  
 of my Double Spring Traps with Spring  
 He left one of his small traps with me till  
 He returned mine gave him my Big  
 trap he will pull a Tongue in it  
 it cost me 2.50 gave him a Shank  
 Skin a Decoy What Stones took his  
 Stone Sifter that he gave me Putting  
 out Manure in the Upper field on the Manure  
 Seander crossed for the Mail got a Decoy

 a small owl Putting out Manure
