I dug out mouths of drains ^{on No 3} at culvert to get them put into one outlet. I went to meeting of managers at night they decided to put flag stones in shed I got at Chapman land side also furrell etc for crown plow 55 ds on a/c.

Wednesday

Fine A.M. looked like rain P.M. cloudy some thunder but no rain exceedingly dry. Willie at Maywoods thrashing A.M. Thomas skinned a lamb which died last night they got kind of our roller which is very wobbly the tongue being broken he said he had lots of firm with it. I scuffled turnips. P.M. Willie went down got 5 18 m culvert tiles from J. Malcolm \$6.00 on a/c I took out culvert and we got 2 tiles laid. Willie took lamb skin down sold to Pickle Bargin for 1.25 got meat 45 ds payment rest on a/c. Dow No 3 fugged in bush today we brought the 65 11 living pigs over at night in boiler and pulled out their long black teeth. Mr Mackie brought over 2 ducks for us we lent her some ducks feed.
