- 13 Began to rain before day and mercury ran up to 58 about noon. Got 1 pan of bread 10 cakes yeast 10^{cts} I washed and churned 25-
- 14 Very fine day I got my account from McPherson and it is 31.7, part of it is Burdo & part this Far went to Lancaster tonight.
- 15 Far left this morning for Toronto. Murdy drove him to Lancaster. It was rainy all day, and if does not stop the roads will be nice. I got 3 lbs butter 60
3 pts molasses 45 - at Willis 45 50
Very warm today. Childrens entertainment 88
- 17 Gave in collection 30 30
- 18 Nice and warm Brod went last night to Donald Ross, Miss Bell Kinneday died today Old Kinnell died last week so did old Robert Gary of Front Duncan Smith died Sunday, Kenneth Murchison died last week in Hamspuy was buried here on Wednesday 15th
- 19 Sunday, a good congregation I was not there. I have influenza so has Mam
- 20 Our white cow we found this morning with some of her udder out. We sent for Finlay it was washed and put in and a strip buckled of her udder. Finly gave a wash for leggans wort, cleaned Sablis roe, bound up Jettys leg. charged 1.50 rained all 150 25
forenoon. Far came home from Toronto today
- 21 To Longs 7th Sabbath School convention at Van Cleeks Hill yesterday & today Pa lent a single stove to Mrs Gardenfield today 25
- 22 Annie's birthday. Fine bright day
- 25 Saturday. Far came home yesterday and had a writing desk that he bought in Montreal
