- 13 Began to rain before day and mercury ran up to 58 about noon. Got 1 pan of bread 10 cakes yeast 10cts I washed, and churned 25-
- 14 Very fine day I got my account from Mr Pherson and it is 31.7, part of it is Birds & part Paid Far went to Lancaster tonight.
- 16 Far left this morning for Toronto. Murdy drove him to Lancaster. It was snowing all day, and if does not drift the roads will be nice. I got 3 lbs butter 60
3 qts molasses, 45- at Willis 45 50

- 17 Very warm today. Childrens entertainment
- 18 Gave in collection 30 30
- 18 Nice and warm Bird went last night to Donald Roy's, Miss Bell Kennedy died today. Old Kimmell died last week so did old Robert Cary of Front. Duncan Smith died Sunday, Kenneth Murchison died last week in Wainwright was buried here on Wednesday 15th
- 19 Sunday, a good congregation I was out there. I have influenza so has Marn
- 20 Our white cow we found this morning with some of her "matrass" out. we sent for Finlay it was washed and put in and a strap buckled of her udder. Finlay gave a wash for leggan's wart, cleaned Jabbie's nose, bound up jettie's leg. Charged 1.50 rained all forenoon. Far came home from Toronto today 1.50 25

- 21 To 1 loaf 7cts - Sabbath School convention at Van Cleeks Hill yesterday & today Pa lent a single stove to Mrs Gardenfield today
- 22 Annie's birthday. Fine bright day
- 25 Saturday. Far came home yesterday and had a writing desk that he bought in Montreal
