Five 2 of Lewis's here for Smooth Irons  
Went to Na Houtas Island to Fish  
Stanley and I got 49 Perch. some  
Windy Worms not plenty with  
the Growth Mowing in the West  
field the 3 of them Seander John H  
and Stanley Mowing the Rushes and  
they mowed them before Lots  
of Boats a going to Day 18<sup>th</sup> Fine  
Gunning gathering making coals  
got a Runner for the Jumper Brooke  
one of the Runners Seander crossed for  
the Mail got a Liverpool Mercury  
from Glen in England 19<sup>th</sup> Fine  
Fernandez & B Day 1874 some  
drops of Rain putting a Runner in  
the Jumper all in of the Lower  
end put in a Lot of the upper  
field set a Fire on the Bush  
fence Lewis here for Butter  
and Milk 20<sup>th</sup> very warm  
Boys mowing in the upper field  
about Done of it only what  
at the fence for marsh way  
Why one came

James Cameron Island 21<sup>st</sup> July 1855  
Fine John H went to Hopkins Point  
& Wench 2 here from Lemays for  
Butter 3lb 45 paid 5lb 75 paid 50  
25 Due 22<sup>nd</sup> at Marsh Hay Making  
and gathering Hay Putting in  
the East of the Fine Hay Mr  
Stickler here for Sand John H  
worked 3 Day got 50 cents have  
John H 2.25 for me Lewis 2  
Boys for Butter and Milk  
Gene went to Summers town  
Mowing Back Marsh and  
the Oakfield John H went to the  
Point very warm 24<sup>th</sup> Fine  
Mowing making coals Gene  
went down put a Board and  
the Bell on White cow 25<sup>th</sup>  
Fine Shows in Cornwall  
Mowing in the oakfield Seander  
and John H went to Dundee took  
2 Pails of Butter Lewis Boys for  
Rake Butter Milk St James  
Purting 4 Subs 1 Sub 200 Hour  
Sea Boots
