 He made drills in stump field No 7 with

 lb for it \$3.15 got from Jennie for butter 40<sup>cts</sup>  
 got at Steels dry goods \$11.2 diary salt 40<sup>cts</sup>, paid  
 mother for stockings 25<sup>cts</sup>.
