In this patient, the intolerance of all ferruginous preparations had been so noticeable that it resulted in her having a certain hesitancy or repugnance, so that she could hardly take them before they would be immediately ejected, and I was therefore obliged to employ injections of cacodilates and ferruginous enemias without being able to obtain any marked improvement.
