four at the causeway and two at Parber

May 1

Monday

Hard frost last night cold day windy
sunny and cloudy. We measured from
7 rods corner T.L. down to Gordon St to get
place for end post of new wire fence
we are starting along G. S. we
struck line and measured out some
post holes for Malcolm Campbell who
is digging them. I dressed some
posts. Willie plowed in turnip land
T.L. manure hard to turn down.
Miss Daly and Bob Lindale down straight.

2

Tuesday

Snowing this morning turned to rain.
cleared off in P.M. cool day. Willie
took 11 bgs cow chop to Wilsons and
brought up load manure from Steels in
A.M. we took over load hay at noon
In P.M. Willie plowed turnip land
then brought up chop 55. He got bushel
& his potatoes at Armstrongs on 75¢
also shear at Mannis 40¢ on 75¢.
Received from Mrs McVicar for butter
\$3.36 in cheque. I worked at fence
dressing posts taking down rail and etc Malcolm
Campbell digging post holes all day.
