We finish thrashing at 1.30 P.M. and chored till evening had Charlie Reesor hired yesterday afternoon & today at 75¢ per day

Friday 16th fair
all Choring and I went to town got fork fixed 18¢
sold skins 85¢, got sheep home paid \$3.60
freight, shipped a lamb to Jr Mountains. B.D. Brown 3

Saturday 17th dull & damp
we had Bailey's cutting all day, had C. R. and Ben Byers man helping we cut about a days thrashing of stack and blew it into the barn I hired Charlie Reesor for 13 1/2 months for \$185.00 one hundred and eighty five dollars, his time will be up on Jan 1st 1902, he is not to draw any of his money until his time is up.

Sunday 18th Dull
Father, Mary, baby and I went to Church in morning and we all stayed at home the rest of day.

Monday 19th wet
we hauled chaff to bull pen and chored generally E.D. went to town for a job in afternoon and C. Reesor started work we chored all afternoon, got \$35.00 we have looked over our accounts and I owe W.E. much \$68.66
