Cloudy day started Friday to rain about 10 AM  
 rained till noon off and on then about 5 PM  
 an exceedingly heavy shower with hard thunder  
 and lightning the south field flooded again. I  
 finished plowing the green crop land No 1 1/2  
 we did inside work when raining. PM Willie  
 drove down got at Wilkins mill 415 lbs  
 buckwheat at 90cts \$7.78 10 bushels corn \$9.00  
 200 lbs white dust @ \$1.40 \$2.80 got at Summers  
 seed corn 90 cts at Marnes coal tar 10cts each handle 15  
 he also got the last cutaway harrow gang. He stayed  
 in St Andrews shed during rain.

Saturday

5 Fine sunny day cool. Willie took cream down  
 in morning got girls 20cts milking \$20.00 grain 20 00  
 father a drive. I fixed fence between No 1 & 2  
 Lass got some black smoke on light wagon.

Willie harvested some turnip land before dinner. PM  
 we disked green crop land cutaway harrow & horses  
 planted 4 more rows potatoes with planter.

2073 I made some of board gate for pig pen gate. I went  
 down town at night got tooth filled at Brothers got  
 soda at Summers 5cts.
