- Sept 29th. Drew 3 loads of hay to the stable at the cement works.
- Oct 2nd. Went to Galt Fair, having dinner with Mr & Mrs Buchanan. Took a dog skin to the tannery to get a pair of gauntlets made.
- 3rd. Went to Uncle Charlie Steuber's funeral in the afternoon. Mother came up from Brantford and went with me.
- 4th. Went to Anniversary Services in the Baptist Church, St George in the evening.
- 5th. Went to Brantford in the afternoon, taking a load of apples etc. to Mrs Kitchie, brought a wash stand home which Mother gave me.
- 7th. Finished picking stones off Lucerne meadow (north half) about 8 loads of small stones in all. Went to Prayer Meeting at B. Atkins in the evening.
- 8th. Bought of W. Coster 6 headlith bulles ²⁵/₁₀ 1 dog, narcissus etc. ²⁵/₁₀
- 9th. Helen Franklin started to cut the corn with the binder.
- 10th. A very heavy rain in the afternoon.
- 12th. Thanksgiving Day, the weather was ideal. Mother, Hattie and Gordon's the baby came over for the day. ³ had a little calf. ^(Dance)
- Started to fill the silo and finished about ten o'clock on Jan. The silo was heaped up and a few loads left besides an acre of ear corn. The corn went in in fine shape, well matured and well cared.
- 13th. Helped R. McDonald to fill his silo and drain in the citrons, pumpkins & Squash.
- Helped Skred to fill his silo.
