Sept 19 went to Mr Gards with Mr Bilton wife & daughter Ellen & Bessie ^{every thing} ^{hilled} Mr Deane & wife stopt all night, came all Mr Biltons to meet

21 came to Delta got dinner at Mr Highecks got Lizzie at Mr Danites got home about 8 o'clock all well

22 went to Exat for loath for the church got none Mr greer is in present at drill brought a lot of hair for the church & some tan bark for the garden, but the heffers hide from Mr Parr paid him \$3.60 for his half of it weight 4 1/2 fifty cents per lb

23 worked at the church part of the forenoon went an Agriculture meeting in the afternoon Mr ^{hills to night} garden came

24 the Revd Mr Cochran preached in the morning

25 Gandy went to Abraham McNeil for 3 Lybert for some slaughterhooks half the day, ^{the garden for straining} 3 diged part of

26 Gandy went to Mr Roton for Ellen in the forenoon he drooged a part of the middle field that was plowed late rain I finished the Strawberry bed diged the early rose potatoes had 2 large pools full of a little ^{morning} rain this

27 went to Kingstons in the Provincial Show the judges all went & Gandy came home with the 9 o'clock train it was a fine show the governor general & quite the Lieutenant Governor of Ontario & New Brunswick was there today

28 went back again today to attend a musical meeting there was a very large attendance from the west & others to the meeting ^{from the west} came at two to see the meeting did not mind of

29 came home by the express got about 1 o'clock ^{from} the Compositing went 3 got more than ever choice

30 the Revd Messrs Smart & Gordon came down tonight I took them to Kingstons today & they reached the Revd Mr ^{at}
