The Rev'd Mr Cochran preached in the morning & the

at Mr Gards got home about 8 o'clock all well

22 went to Ercat for bats for the church got none Mr
Gard is in brent at drill brought a lot of hair
for the church & some tanbark for the garden
got the huffers hide from Mr Parp paid him \$3.60
for his half of it weight $3\frac{1}{2}$ fifty cents per lb

23 worked at the church part of the forenoon went an

Agriculture meeting in the afternoon Mr Gard come

24 the Rev'd Mr Cochran preached in the morning

25 Georgey went to Brooklin Mr Hockeys for 3 bushels for
some slough croaks half the day, 3 bushels for strawberries

26 Georgey went to Mr Roton for Ellenets the forenoon
he droged a part of the middle field that was plowed late

rain I finished the strawberry bed 3 bushels the early rose
potatos had 2 large pools full a little rain this

27 went to King's tors to the Provincial Show

the judges all went & Georgey came home with
the 9 o'clock train it was a fine shower
the Governor general & suite the Lieutenant Governor
of Ontario & few hundred were there to day

28 went back again to day to attend the annual

meeting there was a very large audience

Georgey the next day started for the agricultural

convent of two to one the meeting did not begin

29 came home by the express got about 10 lbs of corn

the company went 3 got more then ever before

30 the Rev'd Legge 8 mts of rain came down last

night thought there to have been a day or two of rain
predicted the same amount
