 straw hat 10 Seed Dr Dickinsons Steamer a nice
 little craft the St Francis a Pleasure Party
 from Coladu to the Landing and then running the
 James Sault came home Mowed a piece Rainy
 8th Sunday Morning some Windy still shining and cloudy
 Writing a Letter to John 15th Box 7th Putting all day hay in
 vana Raining part of the Day 10th Morning Put in a load
 Frank Laplantes Wife a young Daughter 11th Crossed to
 Summers town Early this Morning for My Flour got it
 Bought of Byronds 1 Ten Basin 12th cents Plug of Tobacco paid
 the Postage on the Letter send to John 3 cents Antwine
 Borell came of the St Francis this Morning I came down
 to get at Hamiltons got 3 scythes and a snath from
 in the Jennie running now Burns left wood
 Mr Fulton and Mr Dnetsinger here I went down
 still Fishing with them Took our Dinner at
 the Waterside and our Whisky and Beer 12th
 went down with them to the Rd but this Morning
 got a good sized Pike Mrs Dnetsinger did Trowle
 at the horse shoe (15) Mr Fulton Brought
 me a singared cured Ham and a Sack of Flour
 he says my Lunge weighed 26 one got a Mether
 15th one he got 2 lbs Mather had Mr Suthell here
 gave him an arrow point Morning 13th Morning Mowing
 here 2 Miss Sweets and 2 Mr Swats left 50 cents
 Peter Back the Indian showing them gave me a cigar
 erg. Fine People they seem to be they are from
 Potsdam Nicolville where the live in Indian here
 or Maties this Morning gave him some heard
 the Steamer York Propeller was burnt
