Fernandez crossed to see if they came
on the afternoon Boat they were not
there corn about ripe cut some stalks
5th John Angus's Birth Day Fair
in Williamstown Fernandez went
to Cornwall to get his Bicycle fixed
a Sturgeon channel fat and an ell yesterday
2 Sturgeon Stanley Mowing and Coring in the
Front Marsh. Few drops of Rain high Wind
Fernandez traded his Wheel Leander went
to Williamstown to the Fair seen the Mon-
ument that Dan put up seen John Angus Folks
Bought 1 lb Tea Box of matches 6th Fine
Windy Fernandez went to Fair in Williamstown
Ed and Silly here Brought crab apples
2 men for Bates Ridley cutting in the Marsh
Putting in some ears of corn cut some
stalks husking to night Minnie came from
Randolph Made a Stack of Marsh hay
Fair in Cornwall Has sold 21 Egg Eggs
Bought Tea Soap Sugar Chumney

Wm's Cameron Island September the 8th 1849
Fine Began cutting in the Back Marsh Made
some coils Lucias for Tobacco 15 Potatoes 25
Peter Back for Butter 36 husking some
9th a very fine Day Made a Stack of Marsh hay
out of Back Marsh put some in the North-
-end of the Stable Leander crooked to Post office
Gordon and Fernandez came from Penhaws
Whipping their Barn 10th Adelaide and Minnie came
10th cut the corn fine 12th Fine Cutting Corn stalks
and Husking corn Eddy here got a Paper
from Bill with the Bonnie Brooming
Heather in it from Bonnie Scotland
13th Fine cool Leander and Fernandez went
to Mill with the last of the Wheat
Bought a small shaving glass Taking in
corn husking at night Cutting Corn stalks
Eddy for Eggs to Day Making Crab apple
Jelly Horses in the upper field 14th
Fine cool Windy Took in the last of the
corn cutting the last of the corn stalks
Husking to night Keeping the Horses in
at night putting corn in the Boathouse
Leander to Summerstown Eddy for his
Scythe Lucias for Potatoes 25 cents 15th Fine going
Corn stalks Leander to Summerstown to Pack of Salt
12 young chickens out now pretty late
1 lb of Tea Gordon took his Box of Tools
