4 Very hot said to be 93 in the shade done a little baking for the Pic Nic. tomorrow. Dolly had a calf today

5 Another hot day we were at the picnic. Marion Ran & I. more subtle. Jimmie & Murdy got chances. Bird did not go. George McGilbray read an address & Family Circle presented the money I do not know how much

6 I heard today that there was \$194⁰⁰. Yesterday Craig & Caldwell of the front were gathering a purse for the family of the Rev. McKay. He gave \$3⁰⁰

7 Womens meeting at J. S. 27 persons present I was

14 Got two lb tea at Willie's 90cts Working at
15 Ray got 2 lb rice 1 lb chuse = 10 - 15

16 put in some hay. My Aunt Kate came here
16 rains last night. put in three loads hay

17 Mrs McKay Hunt preached today. A large number
refusing in Montreal burnt some lives lost
I think it was on Thursday
