## Hook Worm Disease.

That it is not necessary, and may be harmful, to starve patients during treatment for hook worm disease is the opinion of Keith. He prefers betanaphthol, in 30-grain doses every morning to both eucalyptus and thymol. The prognosis depends on the degree of anemia. If the hemoglobin is around 60 per cent. the ova will disappear in the course of a few days; if the hemoglobin is below 40 per cent. it may take weeks or months before a cure is effected.—*Lancet*.
