 9 10 dust at \$1.35 per cut \$8.10 paid by cheque R.B. he gave another 45 ds. The girls and I drove over to M. Kees at night for tea and evening P.M. in buggy she is very lame.

Ground covered with snow this morning sunny and cloudy snow blusters and stormy cold. We cleaned seed oats cut wood in woodshed and Willie oiled I Allan harness. We got cheque from John Spence for oats got Monday \$8.70. Mary at Barbours patriotic meeting P.M.

Hard frost last night. Sunny. Thawing in sunshine. I cut wood in hardwood bush we brought over load also harrows 9 AM. Mary and I drove down P.M. went to church Rev Mc Donald of Belwood preached from Acts 18. I must by all means attend this feast. Geo  
 3 25 Luther Armstrong baptised. We took 11 doz eggs to Fed @ 20 ds each got Hattie 30 ds + 5 sacks bran @ 50 balance \$4.60 a. af. ch. coll 5 ds. Isabelle Armstrong came up with us stayed for tea I drove her up evening. Shot trail & white in P.M. looking at cattle. Mary got at Woods goods 50 ds meat 100
