Frosty at both ends of day sunny and semi sunny at times throwing some. Willie brought up two loads of manure from Sandersons a.m. and one P.M. we spread two of them <sup>and one</sup> on pile. I cleaned seed barley a.m. P.M. I went down with Willie took <sup>Mary got goods a.m. 5.25 in this</sup> 3 1/2 day eggs to Russells on f.c. then met J.C. Richardson at Wilsons office to see about settling the Jno Hay estate as we were appointed executors. I got post cards and stamps at Phillips 30 cts Mary got yarn at Stubs a.m. 32 cts she came up this a.m. Willie paid Bart 45 cts for sharpening harrow teeth. I got spark plug from D.W. Thompson 75 cts. Willie took manure down to station in morning. I gave Beattie cheque for £20. 1/10 to \$200. government bonds we applied for.
