 31 I & Aaron helped B. C. draw in their
 barley with team. W. fine clear
 August 1 Aaron harrowed fallow Am & hoed thistles
 out of feed Corn & Potatoes Pm. I went to B. O.
 & shuffled turnips second time W. fine warm
 2 I & John & Susanna went to Toronto sold Eggs
 @ 16. Butter @ 18¢ little Chickens @ 25¢
 Aaron hoed & cut road round barley. W. pretty
 3 Cut nearly all our barley B. C. men helped W. cloudy
 4 Finished cutting & binding & shocking barley till 3
 Pm. then I shuffled turnips & Aaron & Mainland
 hoed. W. very warm & sultry
 5 drew in 12 loads wheat W. very warm & sultry
 Sunday 6 at home all day Isaac Meyer's were here Pm
 of finished drawing in wheat 7 loads then men
 hoed turnips John began to rake stubbles & I went
 to Belford & to I Meyer's after supper W. clear
 8 Cut spring wheat B. C. cut it with his reaper
 we got it all shocked & drew in rakes by hand
 9 drew in our barley B. C. helped with team Am
 W. warm clear

10 Aaron helped ^{at 9} M. D. & the Mesh Mainland pulled Peas
 11 Aaron & Mainland pulled Peas I went to ^{W. warm}
 This morning then I & little boys drew in spring
 wheat 5 loads it is a good sample & a good crop
 but the fall wheat is generally poor some farmers
 are stacking it in their yards for manure. W. warm
 12 all pulled Peas W. very warm & sultry
 Sunday 13 I & Adeline & John staid with my
 Mother Mary & the rest went to Meeting at Altona
 Henry Barneys widow & son Samuel & two day at
 week here Pm. C. Barkeepers awhile W. very warm
 14 all pulled Peas. W. very warm. sultry
 15 Finished pulling Peas till 3 Pm
 then pulled headlands behind barn began
 pulling with rake awhile this evening
 works very well, W. pretty warm Red J or
 Barneys called awhile Pm
 16 Aaron & Mainland helped thresh at B. C. I & John
 & Harvis pulled some Peas with rake then Susan
 Coker & her man John Boyer came & staid all day
 I cut road round oat field north of Orchard
 this evening. W. fine clear
 17 Commenced to cut oats a very slight
 shower stopped us B. C. men went home
 cut a few ourselves Am they came & helped
 Pm. W. very sultry & close. P. B. called Pm
 18 Finished cutting & binding Oats Am I John & Aaron
 finished pulling Peas with rake & Mainland shocked
 Oats W. pretty warm
 19 drew in 12 loads Peas. W. very warm
 Sunday 20 John & girls went to Meeting at Widdemans
 Ann went with B. C. No. J. D. were here W. fine Cool
 14 Converts were Baptized today by Bu Christian
 21 I & John finished cutting Oats tholy Mainland
 bound all near grassy and Aaron helped B. C. No. Thresh
 22 B. C. two men helped & we finished binding Oats
 Am drew in 10 loads Peas Pm B. C. team helped W. clear
 23 I & Aaron & John drew in 10 loads Peas Mainland helped
 Sanders on thresh W. warm clear
