little children got the first paper of the news
or the Toronto Weekly News but got the
Picture last week Father of Confederation
7th Windy drifting fine sawing stove wood
8th Cold Windy cutting stone wood 9th Went
to Summerstown Bought of I Summerv.
4500 wt of Flour 10 Dollars got a Receipt
up to Date Bought Cotton had this Thread
paid this 10th Came from Hamilton with
the Boards and flour Gordon came down
with them got Bag of Grain from Hamilton
on credit Traded Coats with Gordon a
Fine Day 11th Fine 8th Fishers on the ice at
Christies Island seen ^{in the 2nd day} fine over on the south side
12th St. Georges Day Cold Windy drifting Day
in the Barn of the shed birds flying about
13th Stormy N West and South Wind Drifting
Snowing lots of small Birds like Sparrows about
here caught 3 of them awful plenty about the
House and Barn finding the axes down
Stove Wood 14th Starley's B Day 1880 Fine
Cutting Water holes for the cattle shovelling snow as
there was Big Bankings shaved a good deal to do
15th Started to go to Summerstown turned back
John Hamilton here put some hay of the shed
Leander not well began the hay on the
West now yesterday 16th Putting up Hay
fine a Ram Lamb to day

Mr James Cameron had 17th March
St Patrick's Day the Festival of the Irish
cold windy fine Leander went for mail got them at
Hamilton 18th St Joseph Day on this Day last year
Victor Departed fine 19th Spring commences to
day fine putting in hay of the shed seen 2 Wild Geese
going east flying low to the ice cutting stove wood
20th Fine warm commenced to rain went to the
Bush Leander and J. J. Men fishing ells at the Point
21st Fine Windy high high Wind West Hailing in the Bush
22nd Luraria Senior Birth Day Leander tried for ells
water on the ice crust not good freezing some to night
Robins came yesterday 23rd Shopping in the Bush Windy
one cold 3 teams came down the ice looks like some
ice moving over to the south side some crust
cutter went up the ice 24th Fine Windy frosty
of the teams came up to day and I came back in
the Bush pulling Limbs 25th Palm Sunday Commencement of
the year in Main Bismarck here gave him 50c and wrote
Lewis the Indian here 2 Indians drowned in Cromer
with the Freshet a big stain of John Mc Giffen
leaving one of the men and never helped them
ice good 26th John Hamilton Camerons B.W.
Day 1876 cutting stove wood 27th Bismarck here
on the sap buckets got 66 Went to Summerstown
Bought of Mr Ward Tea 50 Tobacco 52 cents
spectacles 28th John Carey Poorly Fetterby
arrested in Lancaster having fine some rain
water & slush on the ice 28th Wild Geese and Ducks
to day fine rain foggy put in a stack 3 tons
Wind turned to West the boat went down to Lower Point
hook shot of wild that got bare of ones
hopped some to night 29th Fine Shaving 14 Wind
by 7 o'clock very sore with joints split an ash for dinner
boiling hard to night soaked straggen in the water
