Willie took straw down to Smalls got at Mannis shear 30cts Dick shod Jenuplis 25 + 12cts last time harness mended at M<sup>c</sup> 30  Dennots 10cts roller sharpened at Hodge 37  50. brought up load manure from stable 10  I spread it on No 5 along Garden street. 50  In P M Mary went down with Lucy got at Stals diary salt 40 groceries 45  paid 55 dr bills \$1.60 due bill at F wts 45  groceries 33 eggs sold 32 at Neills meat 45 32  got Lucy shod Hodge 25 got goods at Russell and Armstrong wifes wool oil Reams 1 gal 23 25  We took down fence along creek down No 5 and plowed some of it with intention of using road machine on it.  We got butter cheese yesterday \$6.75 675</p>
