Fine cool sunny day. I scuffled potatoes in a.m. and Willie disked in No 4. In P.M. we ultimately disked and cut down trees a strip in No 6 brush.

Wednesday

Fine sunny day not so cool as yesterday. We plowed out a drain in No 4 running N.E. to main S.E. The said drain parallel with and 10 ft South of drain we put in 2 yrs ago. we got it dug out so deep the whole length 4 chains more or less and on chain whole depth also laid 50 ft or so of tile 3 in. Belle and Mary over to Elora in P.M. to see Smith Optician but he was not at home. They got at Phillips machine needles 5⁰ at Stubs on aft goods \$1.32

Thursday

Fine sunny day. I worked at drain Willie scuffled corn. In P.M. he took down 5 bags pig chop also wool to Russells 73³/₄ lbs at 2⁰ \$19.16 on aft got at Woods hicks & eggs 3 cts. Girls and I up at Sindals at night. butter 32. paid mother helping 25

Warm sunny day. We plowed out new drain from outlet in No 4 North to other fence. Willie scuffled in aft. In P.M. both worked at drain. Girls at church in P.M. coll 5⁰ got dug shed at Dupler's 10 at Amstutz's repairs 10 got at Stubs on aft shoes 2.00 other goods 59 took to Amstutz on aft 30 lbs butter at 15 cts \$4.50. Willie down town at night on wheel sent letter to I.J.M. Co also sent sample of weed and stuff from drain to O.A.C. 2
