cleared out air cellar heavy rain
- 27 drew in the potatoes to our cell in the usual way
- 28 pulled 6 load of turneps rained A.M. in the forenoon heavy rain in the afternoon

1 they were 5 snows got 12.5 per barrel

- 5 went to Lynn with pork barrels & put in
I borrowed 250 bricks from C. Ross
- 6 drew wood from the Cresties place
- 7 went to Brockville with 4 barrels of App
2 for Turnes & 2 for his clerk got 10
brought 1 side of sole leather 9 1/2 full
the Revd Mr Mc Murray preached in evening
- 8 heavy rain most of the day his horse
- 9 heavy rain most of the night helped to kill
- 10 took Rob & one went to Leachs farm to look
at it farm of Leachs good land but
very poor here
- 11 worked at the foundation of a house
