29 Monday

Fine sunny warm AM clouded over rained heavy late PM and evening, thunder and lightning I disked No 1 mangel land cutaway harrow AM Willie took cream to Russells got at Begins meat 50 & 70 I mangel seed 50 at Mr. Demots bit 10cts
170 Mauds colt died this at noon I buried it in No 2.

We disked and harrowed potato land PM and sowed 4 rows potatoes as follows 1st row from corn starting at bottom of row Wickes got at P & I up to nearly opposite elm tree in No 2 () then Irish Cobler or Early Sunrise got at 7 & 8 from thence top of No 1 down No 2 to () from bottom then from thence to bottom kind got from mother and up 3rd row to () then Cornnet to top of 3rd row and down to opposite elm tree in 4th row
rest common

Willie brought 7 & M up AM drive then down in evening again.

Rained almost continually last night apparently the most rain in the spring of rains. sunny and cloudy day got cool at night. We let water off No 6 N.W. of bush land also No 5 in the former piece the water was flowing over the land from across the road in a heavy stream
