Rectal Hint.

Pus coming from the rectum is often due to an infection of one of the crypts. This may be ascertained by bending a probe into the shape of a shepherd's crook, about one-half inch from the end, and introducing it gently into the rectum. On gradually withdrawing it, the bent end catches in the mouth of the crypt. Normally, the end of the probe will enter the crypt less than one-eighth of an inch without causing pain. Should a crypt be diseased, the patient feels a sudden sharp pain, while the instrument penetrates to a depth much greater than normal.—Wagner; Int. Journ. of Surg.
