- 21 Both boys got home about 2 A.M. Mary Mac Lennan who here last night.
- " Jimmie got the cheque cashed \$11.25. To 30 lbs flour 1.60 Paid Jimmie 20 I got for Ann Hall 1.90
- " on the 11th Paid C Callanach 1.44 for butter 1.44
- " Paid Murdy 60 for 10 loaves, To 3 loaves 18 78

- 23 Fine bright day, A little Montroy boy married today to a girl from E Dugwells house on Warranck sent the Montreal Standard Christmas Pictorial to Marion
- 24 Ann Hall 1/2 day 30⁰⁰ 2 loaves 12 1 lb butter 25⁰⁰ ~~67~~
- 25 Mrs St Thomas sent in word that her three younger children were down with measles and her oldest boy only getting over them and they were hard up. I sent 1 loaf some tea sugar a little butter. In evening I sent her two loaves and a bit of cheese, Jimmie sent them 4 loaves by Harper 29⁰⁰ 1 can Currant To 1 lb butter 25- 4 loaves 24 49
- 26 Stormy all day, yesterday Burns birthday was fine, there was a good entertainment in the Hall, under the auspices of the Young Peoples Guild. It was like a Burns birth day. I had a letter from Marion today and her photo. it looks well
